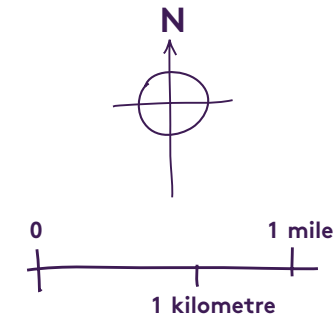
Power driven vessels must be registered before going on the lake.
